Change to COVID Isolation Rules

- Isolation requirements for close contacts have changed. Staff and students can return
 to school as long as they have no symptoms, complete a daily rapid antigen testing
 (RAT) and wear a mask indoors.
- For students and staff who have tested positive and have completed the 7 days isolation period, it is recommended they wear a mask for an additional 3 days.
- Students and staff are still encouraged and will be supported to wear a mask if they wish to.

Students who are unwell

- Any student who is unwell must remain at home.
- Parents/guardians will be contacted to collect their child if they present unwell at school.
