What devices can students bring to school?

Please do not purchase ipads/Google Chrome devices or Windows 11/10 S mode IS NOT compatible with NAPLAN and minimum standard tests.

Wireless Connectivity



All devices <u>must</u> support 5GHz dual band. (802.11 n/ac wireless)

Note: Not all 802.11 n/ac devices support 5GHz dual band. Your device WILL NOT WORK at school if it does not support 5GHz dual band. See below for alternative.

Memory and RAM



Devices must have a minimum of 250GB storage and 8GB RAM.

Wireless Connectivity - alternative



If a device does not support 5GHz dual band, a *USB dual band wireless adapter* may be purchased to allow the use of Wi-Fi at school.

Operating system



Devices must have the current version of an operating system installed.

Battery life



Devices must last minimum of **6 hours** without charge.

Hardware features



Devices must have a camera and microphone.
